

Frequently asked question EMMaH Website (FAQ EMMaH)

I will not have obtained my Bachelor's degree before the application deadline. Am I still eligible to apply for EMMaH programme?

Yes, that is possible.

During the application, you will need to submit a formal letter from your university stating you will finish your Bachelor before your enrolment in EMMaH programme. In addition, the transcript of records, incl. all courses still on going, should be given as well as the results up to the moment of application.

Which document do I need to provide in order to apply?

You will find the list of the documents you have to provide during your application under the section « how to apply » of the website.

What documents can I provide for the certificate of residence?

You can prove your place of residence with one of these documents, even if you live with your parents:

- Gas, electricity, water or telephone bill (fixed or mobile) less than 6 months.
- Notice of previous year's tax or non-tax (income tax, housing tax or property tax)
- Rent receipt less than 6 months.

Am I eligible to the scholarship?

All students at Master's level from all around the world can apply for the scholarship.

You must hold a Bachelor's degree, be in your last year of Bachelor studies and graduate before the Master's programme starts or be recognised equivalent level of learning according to national legislation and practices in the degree-awarding countries / institutions.

Students who have previously obtained an EMJM scholarship under the programmation 21 - 27 are not eligible to apply for an additional scholarship under the EMJM programme.

English level: I have a state accredited B2 language exam but it is neither IELTS, TOEFL nor Cambridge. Is my certificate meets the requirement or do I have to attest a certificate from the listed exams?

You have to provide the Consortium with either IELTS, TOEFL, TOEIC or Cambridge certificate or attest of a minimum of 2 years full-time studies in English.



What are the admission requirement?

Is duolinguo a sufficient proof of my English level?

No. Our programme does not accept Duolinguo as a sufficient language proficiency certificate.

What is the start date of this programme?

EMMaH Master starts at the beginning of October (next intake to start in October 2024).

Is it allowed to also apply to other Erasmus Mundus Joint Master programmes when applying to EMMaH programme?

Yes, this is allowed.

When is the application deadline for this programme?

For students starting in October 2024, applications will open in November 2023, with deadline Mid-January **2024** (for scholarship students and self-funded students).
